Tariff and Development Board Notice No. 374—Inquiries Concerning Tariff Protection for Various Goods—Public Hearings

1. In a letter of 22 June 1973, the Minister of Customs asked the Board to undertake inquiries into the goods listed in the attached Schedules with the objective of providing Government with a basis for restructuring and updating the Tariff to establish, where

possible, adequate rates of duty protection on the goods involved.

2. For the purpose of taking evidence the Board will hold public hearings commencing at the times and on the dates shown below in the Hearing Room, Eighth Floor, Cumberland House, Upper Willis Street, Wellington.

In a letter dated 6 April 1973, the Minister of Trade and Industry indicated that, while Government has asked the Board to consider the question of a single tariff rate, for trade policy reasons the Board's recommendations on this aspect will not necessarily be made public for the time being.

In preparing this evidence the "Notes for Information and Guidance of Interested Parties" prepared by the Board may be of assistance. Copies of these notes may be obtained from the Board's office.

6. In any instance where no evidence is received in respect of any goods classified within a particular Tariff item, the Board may recommend that no protective rates of duty be applied to those goods.
