#### KAIKOHE BOROUGH COUNCIL NOTICE OF INTENTION TO TAKE LAND

IN the matter of the Municipal Corporations Act 1954, and the Public Works Act 1928:

Notice is hereby given that the Kaikohe Borough Council proposes, under the provisions of the above-mentioned Acts, to execute a certain public work, namely, to lay out and construct a service lane from Wihongi Street through to Broadway; and for the purpose of such public work the lands described in the Schedule hereto are required to be taken.
