PURSUANT to the Agricultural Pests Destruction Act 1967, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. (1) This order may be cited as the Union of Northern Hawke's Bay, Hawke's Bay, and Eastern Hawke's Bay Pest Destruction Order 1973.

(2) This order shall come into force on the 1st day of October 1973.

2. The boundaries of the Northern Hawke's Bay Pest Destruction District (which was constituted by Order in Council on the 24th day of October 1945*), the Hawke's

Bay Pest Destruction District (which was constituted by Order in Council on the 5th day of January 1887), and the Eastern Hawke's Bay Pest Destruction District (which was constituted by Order in Council on the 10th day of April 1946†) are hereby declared united to form one District. The boundaries of which shall be those specified in the Schedule hereto, and it is hereby further declared that the basis on which the Board for the said District shall first levy its general rate shall be the acreage of the land occupied by the ratepayer.
