NOTICE

1. (1) This notice may be cited as the Okaihau College Board of Governors Notice 1973.

(2) This notice shall come into force on the 1st day of December 1973.

2. The Board of Governors of Okaihau College shall be constituted as follows:

- (a) One member appointed by the Auckland Education Board;
- (b) Nine members elected by the parents of pupils attending the school;
- (c) One member co-opted by the Board if and when it thinks fit.

3. The Auckland Education Board shall cease to control Okaihau College and the sole control of that school shall be vested in the Board of Governors constituted by clause 2 of this notice.
