PURSUANT to the Hydatids Act 1968, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. (a) This order may be cited as the Waikouaiti Hydatids Control District Order 1973.

(b) This order shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

2. The area comprising the County of Waikouaiti as from time to time constituted is hereby declared to be a hydatids control district to be called the Waikouaiti Hydatids Control District.

3. The Waikouaiti County Council is hereby appointed to be the hydatids control authority for the Waikouaiti Hydatids Control District.
