## GOLDEN BAY ELECTRIC POWER BOARD

## RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

*Reticulation Loan 1974, \$120,000*

PURSUANT to the Local Authorities Loans Act 1956, the Golden Bay Electric Power Board hereby resolved as follows:

That for the purpose of providing the annual charges on a loan of \$120,000, authorised to be raised by the Golden Bay Electric Power Board under the above-mentioned Act for the purpose of extensions and alterations to supply in Golden Bay, the said Golden Bay Electric Power Board hereby makes a special rate of decimal one one two (0.112) cents in the dollar upon the rateable value of all rateable property of the Golden Bay Electric Power Board District, and that the special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of the loan and be payable yearly on the 31st day of March in each and every year during the currency of the loan, being a period of 10 years, or until the loan is fully paid off.
