Greenmount Drive, Holmes Road, Mahia Road (from Great South Road to Fields Road), Pakuranga Road (from Ti Rakau Drive to the Howick Borough Boundary), Parkwood Place, Pennell Place, Pepler Street, Polaris Place, Reeves Road (from Ti Rakau Drive to Aylesbury Street), Ti Rakau Drive (from Pakuranga Road to Gossamer Drive).

Pouraika	.. Hill and trig. station at map reference, N. 64/365300. Instead of "Ligars".
Puketurua	.. Trig. site situated 3.2 kilometres southeast of Hinuera. Map reference, N. 66/267326. Instead of "Puketuaroa".
