It is to be noted that in accordance with a Special Resolution of the Company so providing, on the foregoing reduction of capital taking effect, the capital of the Company will be further reduced from \$5,203,280 to \$3,000,000 by the cancellation of the said 32,832 unissued ordinary shares of \$20.00 each and of the said 77,332 unissued preference shares of \$20.00 each".
