PURSUANT to the Control of Prices Act 1947, I, Maurice John Belgrave, pursuant to a delegation from the Secretary of Trade and Industry acting under a delegation from the Price Tribunal, hereby make the following price order:

1. This order may be cited as Price Order No. 2266 and shall come into force on the 11th day of April 1974.

2. (1) Price Order No. 2261* is hereby revoked.
(2) The revocation of the said order shall not affect the liability of any person for any offence in relation thereto committed before the coming into force of this order.

3. References in this order to metropolitan areas references to the metropolitan areas described in the Schedule hereto.

APPLICATION OF THIS ORDER

4. This order applies with respect to all Californian oranges sold by way of retail in the North Island of New Zealand.

MAXIMUM RETAIL PRICES OF CALIFORNIAN ORANGES

5. (1) The maximum price that may be charged or received by any retailer for Californian oranges to which this order applies shall be:

 (a) When sold by a retailer carrying on business in any of the metropolitan areas of Auckland or Wellington, or in any of the Cities or Boroughs of Whangarei, Takapuna, Hamilton, Tauranga, Rotorua, Gisborne, New Plymouth, Stratford, Hawera, Wanganui Palmerston North, Napier, Hastings, or Masterton— 22 cents per lb.
