*Amending a Proclamation Defining the Middle Line of a  
Portion of the Auckland-Hamilton Motorway in the City  
of Auckland*

A PROCLAMATION

PURSUANT to section 4 of the Public Works Amendment Act 1947, I, Sir Edward Denis Blundell, the Governor-General of New Zealand, hereby amend the Proclamation dated the 25th day of February 1960, published in the *Gazette*, 10 March 1960, Vol. I, page 316, and registered as Proclamation No. 17442, North Auckland Land Registry (hereinafter called "the former Proclamation") defining the middle line of a portion of the Auckland-Hamilton Motorway in Block XVI, Waitemata Survey District, so that the former Proclamation shall affect not only the land shown situated within the limits coloured red on the plan marked P.W.D. 160855 referred to in the former Proclamation, but also the land described in the Schedule hereto.
