

Award for Gallantry

HIS Excellency the Governor-General has announced that Her Majesty The Queen has been graciously pleased on 29 March 1974 to confer the honour of Member of the Civil Division of the Most Excellent Order of the British Empire for Gallantry on Inspector Joseph Dennis Farrow, New Zealand Police, of Wellington, in recognition of the courage and judgment displayed by him in Wellington on 30 November 1973, which culminated in the arrest of an armed and dangerously emotional offender.

The notice "Honour and Award" appearing in the *Gazette*, 18 April 1974, No. 35, page 715, is amended by the above by the deletion of the word "Force" after "New Zealand Police" and by giving the correct date of the incident as 30 November 1973.
