

LICENCES TO EXPORT WOOL FROM NEW ZEALAND

ACTING under the authority of section 19 (3) of the Wool Marketing Corporation Act 1972, the New Zealand Wool Marketing Corporation hereby appoints 1 July 1974, as the date after which no person shall export any wool, whether as principal, agent, or otherwise, except:

- (a) Under the authority of a licence issued by the Corporation and held by that person; and
- (b) In conformity with such conditions as may be imposed by the Corporation and specified in the licence.

Every person desirous of exporting wool after 1 July 1974, must apply to the New Zealand Wool Marketing Corporation, 18 Brandon Street, P.O. Box 3849, Wellington, for a licence and each licence issued by the Corporation shall as provided in sections 19 (4) and 20 of the Act continue in force until it is surrendered by the licensee or is suspended, varied, or revoked by the Corporation.
