point due east of the southernmost corner of Section 4, Block XIV, Arapawa Survey District; thence due east along a right line to its intersection with meridian of longitude 174° 30′ East; thence due north along that meridian to its intersection with the parallel of longitude 40° 30′ South; thence due west along that parallel of latitude to a point due north of Pukerau Point; thence due south to the point of commencement.
