<b>Table Mountain</b> ..	Feature in the upper Kauaeranga River area. Map reference, N. 49/156374.	<b>House Hill</b> ..	Site of Trig P at map reference, S. 100/964744.
<b>Tauranikau</b> ..	Rock pinnacle in the Coromandel region. Map reference, N. 49/196376. Instead of "Tauranikau Rock" ( <i>Gazette</i> , 1973, p. 365).	<b>Low Peak</b> ..	For a peak of Mt Cook. Map reference, S. 79/798463.
<b>Te Papiri Point</b> ..	Coastal point at the Whiritoa Reserve near Whangamata. Map reference, N. 49/384112. Instead of "Te Rapiiri".	<b>North East Ridge</b> ..	Mountain ridge extending north-easterly from "High Peak" to junction of "Bowie Ridge" and Zurbriggen Ridge at Mt Cook.
<b>Te Rimupotaka Point</b> ..	For point at the northern shores of Lake Taupo. Map reference, N. 94/509354.	<b>North West Ridge</b> ..	Mountain ridge extending from "West Ridge" at Mt Cook.
<b>Te Tuhi Track</b> ..	For the track over the Kaimai Range from Whakamarama to Okauia. Instead of "Tui" or "Tuhi Track".	<b>Porter Col</b> ..	The high col between Middle Peak and Low Peak at Mt Cook. Map reference, S. 79/801465.
<b>Tihiroa</b> ..	Locality and hill approximately 8 km north of Otorohanga. Instead of "Tiheroa".	<b>Stony Beach</b> ..	Coastal feature at Banks Peninsula. Map reference, S. 85/3738. Instead of "Stony Bay".

<b>Webb Creek</b> ..	A tributary of Kauaeranga River. Map reference, N. 49/168359.	<b>Pawnbroker Rock</b> ..	The rock bivouac at the head of the Tutoko River, Fiordland National Park.
<b>Windy Point</b> ..	Coastal point approximately 1 km north of the northern boundary of Thames Borough. Map reference, N. 49/014313.	<b>Scylla and Charybdis</b> ..	The twin minor peaks between Popes Nose (peak) and Aeroplane Peak on the Main Divide in Mt Aspiring National Park.
