A PROCLAMATION

PURSUANT to section 14 of the Wildlife Act 1953, I, Sir Edward Denis Blundell, the Governor-General of New Zealand, hereby revoke the proclamations issued on the 28th day of November 1962* and the 21st day of December 1962†, declaring an area of land in Block XIII, Hakataramea Survey District, and in the Waimate Acclimatisation District, to be a wildlife refuge for the purposes of the Wildlife Act 1953.
