ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 15th day of July 1974

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Hydatids Act 1968, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. (1) This order may be cited as the Ellesmere-Malvern Hydatids Control District Order 1974.

(2) This order shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

2. The areas comprising the Counties of Ellesmere and Malvern as from time to time constituted are hereby declared to be united to form a hydatids control district to be called the Ellesmere-Malvern Hydatids Control District.

3. The Ellesmere-Malvern Hydatids Control Committee is hereby appointed the hydatids control authority for the Ellesmere-Malvern Hydatids Control District.
