

*The Traffic (Tauranga County) Notice No. 2, 1974*

PURSUANT to the Transport Act 1962, the Minister of Transport hereby gives the following notice.

## NOTICE

1. This notice may be cited as the Traffic (Tauranga County) Notice No. 2, 1974.

2. The roads specified in the Schedule hereto are hereby declared to be 40-miles-an-hour speed limit areas for the purposes of regulation 27A of the Traffic Regulations 1956\*.

3. The Traffic (Tauranga County) Notice No. 1, 1974, dated the 23rd day of January 1974†, regulation 27A of the Traffic Regulations 1956\*, which relates to roads situated in Tauranga County at Papamoa, is hereby revoked.
