PURSUANT to the Electric Power Boards Act 1925, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. (i) This order may be cited as the Central Waikato Electric Power District Representation Order 1974.

(ii) This order shall come into force on the date of the next general election of members of local authorities.

2. The constituent districts of the Central Waikato Electric Power District, which are bracketed together in the first column of the Schedule hereto, shall be a combined district for the purpose of the said Act.

3. The local authority of the constituent district distinguished in the first column of the said Schedule by the letter "(P)" shall be the principal local authority for the said combined district.

4. The number of representatives of each constituent district or combined district of the Central Waikato Electric Power Board shall be the number specified in the said Schedule opposite the name of that constituent district or combined district.

5. The Order in Council apportioning representation on the Central Waikato Electric Power Board dated 4 June 1968, and published in the *New Zealand Gazette* on 20 June 1968 at p. 1024 is hereby revoked.
