THE Auckland Regional Authority in exercise of the powers vested in it by the Auckland Regional Authority Act 1963, section 43, and in pursuance of the authority conferred upon it under the Local Authorities Loans Act 1956, and in exercise of all the powers enabling it on that behalf doth hereby resolve by special resolution intended to operate as a special order to raise the sum of ten million dollars (\$10,000,000) as a special loan to be known as Drainage Loan No. 81, 1973; \$10,000,000 for the purposes of and incidental to the extending of the Manukau sewage purification works. The foregoing special order was passed at an ordinary meeting of the Auckland Regional Authority held on 15 July 1974, and confirmed at an ordinary meeting of the said authority held on 19 August 1974, having meantime been advertised in the *Auckland Star*, on 24 July and 7 August.
