Any authority given by the Tribunal under this clause may apply with respect to a specified lot or consignment of oranges, or may relate generally to all Swaziland oranges to which this order applies sold by the retailer while the approval remains in force.

DUTY IMPOSED ON RETAILERS

6. Every retailer who offers or exposes any Swaziland oranges for sale in any shop shall keep in a prominent position in such proximity to the oranges to which it relates as to be obviously descriptive thereof, a ticket, placard, or label on which shall be stated in legible and prominent characters the following particulars:

(a) The retail price per pound of the oranges. Retailers to whom clause 4 (1) (b) of this order applies shall state at least the prices for 1 lb and 2 lb lots.

(b) The word "Swaziland".
