(iii) The Professor of Education and Head of Subject in the School of Education of the University of Waikato;

(iv) Four other members of the Council of the University of Waikato being those members appointed

by the Governor-General except that where one of those members is the Chancellor of the University, three members only shall be appointed.

(e) One member, to be appointed by the Minister of Education on the nomination of the South Auckland Regional Branch of the New Zealand Secondary School Boards Association and who shall be a member of that Association;

(f) One member, to be appointed by the Minister of Education on the nomination of the Dominion Executive of the New Zealand Educational Institute;
(g) One member, to be appointed by the Minister of Education on the nomination of the Executive of the

- Education on the nomination of the Executive of the New Zealand Post Primary Teachers Association;

 (h) One member, to be appointed by the Minister of Education on the joint nomination of the Local Free Kindergarten Associations of Ward No. 2 of the New Zealand Free Kindergarten Union Incorporated;

 (i) One member, being a member of the academic staff of the Hamilton Teachers College, elected by the academic staff of that College;
