Shooting hours: 6.30 a.m. to 6.30 p.m. except that during the period 3 June 1975 to 5 October 1975 inclusive, and midnight 6 February 1976 to 21 March 1976 at midnight inclusive, Canada goose may be shot 24 hours per day.

Decoy limit: No limit.

Special Conditions

Persons holding valid game shooting licences for the Westland Acclimatisation District may, without taking out a further game licence, shoot in that portion of the Southern Lakes Acclimatisation District included in the Westland Land District.

Also in that portion of the Society's district north of a straight line extending from the Lumsden road-rail bridge to East Dome on the Society's eastern boundary)	3 May to 4 May 1975 incl.
Pukeko	3 May to 2 June 1975 incl.
Pheasants	3 May to 27 July 1975 incl.

Chukor (only in that portion of the Southland Acclimatisation District north of the main highway between Gore and Te Anau)

Canada goose (only in that portion of the Southland Acclimatisation District north of a direct line commencing at Paddock Hill, on the Society's western boundary, to the summit of Mount Hamilton situated at the eastern end of the Takitimu Mountains, then in a direct line to the Te Anau - Lumsden Highway at Centre Hill Station, then along the Te Anau - Lumsden Highway to the road-rail bridge over the Oreti River near Lumsden, then in a direct line to East Dome on the Society's eastern boundary)
