CONDITIONS

(2) The term of the licence shall be 14 years from the 1st day of March 1975.

(3) The premium payable by the licensees shall be twenty dollars (\$20) and the annual sum so payable by the licensees shall be one hundred dollars (\$100); provided always that the Minister may review the annual sum payable at the end of the first year or any subsequent year of the said term.

Amending the Foreshore Licence Authorising Fiordland Travel Limited to Occupy a Site for a Pontoon Jetty at Milford Sound
