ORDER

- 1. This Order may be cited as the East Otago Pest Destruction District Order 1975.
- 2. The boundaries of the East Otago Pest Destruction District, which was constituted by Order in Council on the 25th day of March 1974*, are hereby redefined and, as from the commencement of this Order, the boundaries of the said district shall be those specified in the Schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE

BOUNDARIES OF THE EAST OTAGO PEST DESTRUCTION DISTRICT ALL that area in the Otago Land District, Counties of Maniototo, Taieri, Waihemo, Waikouaiti, and Waitaki, Boroughs of Port Chalmers and Waikouaiti and City of Dunedin containing 336550 hectares, more or less, bounded by a line commencing at Trig.
