*Licensing the Wellington Workingmen's Club and Literary Institute Inc. to Occupy a Site for a Slipway at Breaker Bay*

PURSUANT to section 162 of the Harbours Act 1950, I, Peter Edward Muers of the Ministry of Transport, in exercise of powers delegated by the Minister of Transport, hereby license and permit the Wellington Workingmen's Club and Literary Institute Inc.
