(a) The land on which potato cyst nematode has been found—

(i) An area of 6 acres 1 rood 9.8 perches, or thereabouts, situated north of and adjoining the Tomes Road, Rutland Street Junction, Christchurch, partly in the City of Christchurch and partly in Block XI of the Christchurch Survey District, being part of Lot 4 on Deposited Plan No. 14182, part of Rural Section 1048, C.T. 763/16 (Canterbury Registry).
