Station 27, Taumatani, and the westernmost corner of Wharawhara Block; thence north-westerly along that right line and its production to the middle of the Mangapuaka Stream; thence down the middle of that stream to and up the middle of the Whangai Stream to and northerly along the eastern boundary of Section 14, Block XV, Takapau Survey District, to and down the middle of the Taurekaitai Stream to and up the middle of the Whatatuna Stream to the southern boundary of Lot 3, D.P. 4265; thence westerly along the southern boundaries of Lots 3, part Lot 2 and Lot 1 on that D.P. to and down the middle of the Mangapurakau Stream to a point in line with the north-western boundary of Lot 2, D.P. 2162; thence to and north-easterly along that boundary to the south-western side of a public road; thence along a right line to and again along the north-western boundary of the said Lot 2 to the south-western boundary of Lot 1, Deeds Plan 455; thence north-westerly along that boundary to the south-eastern side of a public road; thence along a right line to and again along the south-western boundary of the said Lot 1 to the westernmost corner of the said Lot 1; thence generally north-easterly along the north-western boundaries of that lot and Section 5, Block VII, Takapau Survey District, to the northernmost point of that section; thence generally easterly and southerly along the northern boundary of the said Section 5 and its production to the middle of the Mahara-keke Stream; thence down the middle of that stream to and down the right bank of the Makaretu, Tukipo, and Tukituki Rivers to the eastern side of the Wellington-Napier railway; thence southerly along that side to the northern boundary

of Waipukurau Block (30N); thence easterly along that boundary to the eastern boundary of Lot 1, D.P. 1667; thence northerly along the production of the last-mentioned boundary to the middle of the Tukituki River and down the middle of that river to the point of commencement; excluding therefrom the Borough of Waipukurau as described in *New Zealand Gazette*, 1968, page 1712.

Plants Declared Noxious Weeds in the Town District of Manaia (No. 1102 Ag. 20649A)

PURSUANT to a delegation from the Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries under the Ministry of Agriculture and Fisheries Act 1953 for the purposes of the Noxious Weeds Act 1950, the following special order made by the Manaia Town Council on 11th day of March 1975 is hereby published.

SPECIAL ORDER

"THAT pursuant to the provisions of the Noxious Weeds Act 1950 and amendments, the Manaia Town Council hereby declares by way of special order that the plants mentioned in the Schedule hereto are noxious weeds within the Town District of Manaia.

SCHEDULE

Barley Grass (*Hordeum murinum*).
Barberry (*Berberis darwinii/vulgaris*).
Blackberry (*Rubus fruticosus/laciniatus*).
Burdock (*Arctium*, any species).
Californian thistle, Canadian thistle or creeping thistle (*Cirsium arvense*).
Cape tulip (*Homeria collina*).
Common broom (*Cytisus scoparius*).
Fennel (*Foeniculum vulgare*).
Foxglove (*Digitalis purpurea*).
Giant buttercup (*Ranunculus acer*).
Gorse (*Ulex*, any species).
Hemlock (*Conium maculatum*).
Lupin (*Lupinus aboreus*).
Milk thistle or variegated thistle (*Silybum marianum*).
Nodding thistle (*Carduus nutans*).
Ragwort (*Senecio jacobaea*).
Russian knapweed (*Centaurea repens*).
Saffron thistle (*Carthamus lanatus*).
Scotch thistle or plume thistle (*Cirsium lanceolatum*).
Silver poplar (*Populus alba var nivea*).
Stinking mayweed (*Anthemis cotula*).
Water hyacinth (*Eichhornia crassipes*).
Winged thistle (*Carduus tenuiflorus/pycnocephalus*)."
