#### NOTICE

- 1. This notice may be cited as the Traffic (Hamilton City and Waipa County) Notice No. 1, 1975.
- 2. The roads specified in the First Schedule hereto are hereby excluded from the limitation as to speed imposed by section 52 of the Transport Act 1962.
- 3. The road specified in the Second Schedule hereto is hereby declared to be a closely populated locality for the purposes of section 52 of the Transport Act 1962.
- 4. The roads specified in the Third Schedule hereto are hereby declared to be a 40-miles-an-hour speed limit areas for the purposes of regulation 27A of the Traffic Regulations 1956\*
- 5. The Traffic (Hamilton City) Notice No. 1, 1974, dated the 12th day of March 1974<sup>†</sup>, and the Traffic (Hamilton City) Notice No. 1, 1974, dated the 12th day of March 1974<sup>‡</sup> under section 52 of the Transport Act 1962 and regulation 27 and 27A of the Traffic Regulations 1956<sup>\*</sup>, which relates to roads situated within Hamilton City is hereby revoked.

## FIRST SCHEDULE

SITUATED within Hamilton City:
