A PROCLAMATION

PURSUANT to the Public Works Act 1928, I, Sir Edward Denis Blundell, the Governor-General of New Zealand, hereby proclaim and declare that the land described in the Schedule hereto is hereby taken for a State primary school; and I also declare that this Proclamation shall take effect on and after the 22nd day of May 1975.

NORTH AUCKLAND LAND DISTRICT

ALL that piece of land containing 16.8 perches, situated in the City of Auckland, and being Lot 147 of a subdivision of part Allotment 21, Section 8, Suburbs of Auckland. All certificate of title, Volume 589, folio 181, North Auckland Land Registry, limited as to parcels.
