AUCKLAND REGIONAL AUTHORITY
SPECIAL ORDER

THE Auckland Regional Authority in exercise of the powers
vested in it by the Auckland Regional Authority Act 1963,
section 32, and in pursuance of the authority conferred upon
it under the Local Authorities Loans Act 1956, and in exercise
of all other powers enabling it on that behalf, doth hereby
resolve by special resolution intended to operate as a special
order to borrow the sum of fourteen million six hundred
and forty-six thousand dollars (\$14,646,000) as a special loan
to be known as Refuse Disposal Loan No. 1, 1974, \$14,646,000,
for the purposes of and incidental to providing metropolitan
refuse disposal facilities including reimbursement of investiga-
tional and design expenditure incurred prior to loan sanction.

The foregoing special order was passed at an ordinary
meeting of the Auckland Regional Authority held on 21 April
1975 and confirmed at an ordinary meeting of the said Author-
ity held on 19 May 1975 having meantime been advertised
in the *Auckland Star* on 26 April 1975 and 10 May 1975.
