Licensing the Kaipara Co-operative Dairy Co. Ltd. to Occupy a Site for a Barge Landing Ramp, Wharf, and Mooring Dolphins in Kaipara River at Helensville

PURSUANT to section 162 of the Harbours Act 1950, I, Grant Stewart Ellis Milne of the Ministry of Transport, in exercise of powers delegated by the Minister of Transport, hereby license and permit

(hereinafter called the licensee, which term shall include its successors or assigns unless the context requires a different construction) to use and occupy a part of the bed of the Kaipara River at Helensville, as shown on plans marked M.D. 12830 and M.D. (N) 18 and deposited in the office of the Ministry of Transport at Wellington and Auckland, for the purpose of maintaining thereon a barge landing ramp, wharf, and mooring dolphins as shown on the said plans, such licence to be held and enjoyed by the licensee upon and subject to the terms and conditions set forth in the Schedule hereto. The licence of 21 January 1969* is hereby revoked.

SCHEDULE
CONDITIONS

(1) This licence is subject to the Foreshore Licence Regulations 1960, and the provisions of those regulations shall, so far as applicable, apply hereto.

(2) The term of the licence shall be 8 years from the 1st day of January 1975.

(3) The annual sum so payable by the licensee shall be forty dollars (\$40); provided always that the Minister may review the annual sum payable at the end of the first year or any subsequent year of the said term.
