Electronics Industry Training Board Notice 1975

PURSUANT to section 15A of the Vocational Training Council Act 1968, the Minister of Education hereby gives the following notice.

NOTICE

1. This notice may be cited as the Electronics Industry Training Board Notice 1975.

2. (1) There shall be an Industrial Training Board for the Electronics Industry which shall be known as the Electronics Industry Training Board and shall comprise the following members:

- Two members appointed by the New Zealand Radio and Television Manufacturers' Federation;
- One member appointed by the New Zealand Engineering, Coachbuilding, Aircraft, Motor and Related Trades Industrial Union of Workers;
- One member appointed by the North Island Electrical Workers' Union;
- One member appointed by the Radio Technicians Certificate, Telephone and Telegraph Technicians Certificates Co-ordinating Committee;
- One member appointed by the Secretary of Labour;
- One member appointed by the Director-General of Education;
- One member appointed by the Chief Executive Officer of the Vocational Training Council.

(2) In addition to the members specified in subclause (1) of this clause, the Board may co-opt not more than 3 additional members.

3. (1) Subject to the provision of this clause an appointed member shall hold office for a period of 3 years, but may from time to time be re-appointed.

(2) Any co-opted member shall hold office during the pleasure of the Board for a period not exceeding 3 years, but may if eligible be re-appointed.

(3) If any member dies or resigns his office by writing under his hand addressed to the Board or the Chairman or the Secretary thereof, or is absent without leave from the meetings of the Board for 3 consecutive meetings, or while holding office becomes for any reason ineligible to remain a member, the casual vacancy so created shall be filled as soon as practicable thereafter by the appointment of a member in the manner in which the vacating member was appointed, and the member appointed to fill the vacancy shall hold office for the residue of the term of office of the member whom he replaces.

(4) Unless he sooner vacates his office every appointed member of the Board shall continue in office until his successor comes into office.

(5) The powers of the Board shall not be affected by any vacancy in the membership thereof.

4. (1) A deputy member may be appointed, in the same manner as an appointed member, to be the deputy of that member and act in the event of the absence of that member from any meeting or meetings of the Board.

(2) While any person is acting pursuant to subclause (1) of this clause he shall be deemed to be a full member of the Board. The fact that any person so acts shall be sufficient evidence of his authority to do so.
