RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

Flats Construction Loan 1975—\$80,000

PURSUANT to the Local Authorities Loans Act 1956, the Onehunga Borough Council hereby resolves as follows:

"That for the purpose of providing the annual charges on a loan of \$80,000 authorised to be raised by the Onehunga Borough Council under the Local Authorities Loans Act 1956 for the purpose of providing 11 flat units under the Housing Corporation's Community Housing Scheme, the said Onehunga Borough Council hereby makes a special rate of decimal nought two cents (.02c) in the dollar upon the rateable value of all rateable property in the Borough of Onehunga and that the special rate shall be an annual recurring rate during the currency of the loan and be payable over a period of 40 years or until the loan is fully paid off."

The foregoing resolution was passed by the Onehunga Borough Council at a meeting held on Monday, 23 June 1975.
