The Palmerston North High Schools Board of Governors Notice 1975

PURSUANT to section 50 of the Education Act 1964, the Minister of Education hereby gives the following notice.

NOTICE

1. (1) This notice may be cited as the Palmerston North High Schools Board of Governors Notice 1975.

(2) This notice shall come into force on the 1st day of July 1975.

2. The constitution of the Palmerston North High Schools Board of Governors is hereby varied so that the Board shall consist of:

- (a) Two members appointed by the Wanganui Education Board.
- (b) Two members to be elected by the parents of pupils attending Palmerston North Boys High School.
- (c) Two members to be elected by the parents of pupils attending Palmerston North Girls High School.
- (d) Two members to be elected by the parents of pupils attending Queen Elizabeth College.
- (e) Two members to be elected by the parents of pupils attending Freyberg High School.
- (f) Up to two members to be co-opted by the Board of Governors if and when it thinks fit.

Road Transport Industry Training Board Notice 1975

PURSUANT to section 15A of the Vocational Training Council Act 1968, the Minister of Education hereby gives the following notice.

NOTICE

1. This notice may be cited as the Road Transport Industry Training Board Notice 1975.

2. (1) There shall be an Industrial Training Board for the Road Transport Industry which shall be known as the Road Transport Industry Training Board and shall comprise the following members—

- (a) Three members appointed by the New Zealand Road Transport Association (Inc.).
- (b) Two members appointed by the New Zealand Road Transport and Motor and Horse Drivers and Their Assistants' Industrial Association of Workers.
- (c) One member appointed by the Secretary for Transport.
- (d) One member appointed by the Director-General of Education.
- (e) One member appointed by the Chief Executive Officer of the Vocational Training Council.

(2) In addition to the members specified in subclause (1) of this clause the Board may, from time to time and as it sees fit, co-opt not more than two additional members.

3. (1) A deputy member may be appointed, in the same manner as an appointed member, to be the deputy of that member and to act in the event of the absence of that member from any meeting or meetings of the Board.
