America in Block XV, Ruawahia Survey District; thence generally easterly along the generally northern boundaries of part Run 55; to and along the north-western boundary of part Lot 2, D.P. S. 4851, to the point of commencement. As the same is more particularly delineated on plan No. N94/3 deposited at the head office of the New Zealand Forest Service, Wellington.
