*Exemption to Allow Display of Blue Lamp in Terms of Traffic Regulations 1956**

PURSUANT to regulation 25A of the Traffic Regulations 1956*, the Secretary for Transport hereby exempts the vehicles specified in the Schedule hereto from the restriction imposed by regulation 34 (4) of the Traffic Regulations 1956* to allow those vehicles to display a blue lamp, provided the blue lamp displayed is only displayed while the vehicle is stationary at the scene of an emergency or simulated emergency.

Assigning and Amending the Foreshore Licence Authorising the Waitemata County Council to Occupy a Site for a Boat Ramp at Hellyer's Creek in Waitemata Harbour

PURSUANT to the Harbours Act 1950, I, Owen John Conway of the Ministry of Transport, in exercise of powers delegated by the Minister of Transport, hereby give notice that the licence of 20 May 1971* authorising the Waitemata County Council to use and occupy a part of the foreshore and bed of Hellyers Creek, in Waitemata Harbour, as a site for a boat ramp, is hereby assigned to the Takapuna City Council, and I further give notice that the licence is hereby amended by deleting condition 3 from the Schedule to the licence and substituting the following condition:

“(3) The annual sum so payable by the licensee shall be ten cents (10c) payable on demand; provided always that the Minister may review the annual sum payable at the end of the first year or any subsequent year of the said term.”
