Bylaw Fixing the Maximum Speed of Vehicles on No. 80 State Highway (Pukaki-Hermitage) from 80 Metres East of Glencoe Bridge to the Hermitage

PURSUANT to the National Roads Act 1953, and the Transport Act 1962, the National Roads Board makes the following bylaw.

BYLAW

1. This bylaw may be cited as the National Roads Board Bylaw 1975, No. 2.

2. This bylaw shall come into force on the day after the date of its publication in the *Gazette*.

3. In this bylaw "vehicle" has the meaning assigned to it in the Transport Act 1962.

4. No person shall drive or take or permit to be driven or taken any vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 kilometres per hour upon or over No. 80 State Highway (Pukaki-Hermitage) commencing from a point 80 metres east of the Glencoe Bridge and extending generally towards the Hermitage for a total distance of 560 metres.

5. Every person who commits an offence against this bylaw is liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding \$100.

6. National Roads Board Bylaw 1973, No. 2*, is revoked.
