PROVISIONS FOR SPECIAL PRICES

Iotwithstanding anything to the contrary in the foreprovisions of this order, and subject to such conditions, *i*, as it thinks fit, the Tribunal, on application by any *x*, may authorise special maximum prices in respect of Californian oranges to which this order applies where 1 circumstances exist, or for any reason extraordinary es (freight or otherwise) are incurred by the retailer. Any rity given by the Tribunal under this clause may apply respect to a specified lot or consignment of oranges, or relate generally to all Californian oranges to which this applies sold by the retailer while the approval remains ce.

DUTY IMPOSED ON RETAILERS

livery retailer who offers or exposes any Californian es for sale in any shop shall keep in a prominent position in proximity to the oranges to which it relates as to be usly descriptive thereof, a ticket, placard, or label on shall be stated in legible and prominent characters the ving particulars:

The retail price per pound of the oranges. Retailers to whom clause 5 (b) or clause 6 (b) of this order applies shall state at least the price for 1 lb and 2 lb lots.

The word "Californian".
