Fractions of a kilogram shall be calculated at the rate of 49 cents per kilogram. Quantities in excess of 3 kg shall be calculated at the rate of 48.5 cents per kilogram.

- (b) When sold by a retailer carrying on business elsewhere-
 - 1 lb, 23 cents;

 - 2 lb, 45 cents; 3 lb, 68 cents; 4 lb, 90 cents; 5 lb, \$1.13;
- 6 lb, \$1.35.

Fractions of a pound shall be calculated at the rate of 23 cents per lb. Quantities in excess of 6 lb shall be calculated at the rate of 22.5 cents per lb. Or where the scales used by the retailer weigh

in metric weights-

- 1 kg, 50 cents; 2 kg, 99 cents; 3 kg, \$1.49.

Fractions of a kilogram shall be calculated at the rate of 50 cents per kilogram. Quantities in excess of 3 kg shall be calculated at the rate of 49.5 cents per kilogram.

(2) If in respect of any lot of bananas the price calculated in accordance with the foregoing provisions of this clause is not an exact number of cents, the maximum price of the lot shall be computed to the nearest whole cent.

PROVISIONS FOR SPECIAL PRICES

6. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in the foregoing provisions of this order, and subject to such conditions, if any, as it thinks fit, the Tribunal, on application by any retailer, may authorise special maximum prices in respect of any Island bananas to which this order applies where special circumstances exist, or for any reason extraordinary charges (freight or otherwise) are incurred by the retailer. Any authority given by the Tribunal under this clause may apply with respect to a specified lot or consignment of bananas, or may relate generally to all Island bananas to which this order applies sold by the retailer while the approval remains in force. approval remains in force.

DUTY IMPOSED ON RETAILERS

- 7. Every retailer who offers or exposes for sale in any shop any Island bananas to which this order applies shall keep in a prominent position, in such proximity to the bananas to which it relates as to be obviously in relation thereto, a ticket, placard, or label on which shall be stated in legible and prominent characters the following particulars:
 - (a) The retail price per pound of the bananas. Retailers to whom clause 5 (1) (b) of this order applies shall state at least the prices for 1 lb and 2 lb lots.

Or where the scales used by the retailer weigh in metric weights the price per kilogram, and retailers to whom clause 5 (1) (b) applies, shall state at least the prices for 1 kg and 2 kg lots.
