The Traffic (Rodney County) Notice No. 1, 1975

PURSUANT to the Transport Act 1962, the Minister of Transport hereby gives the following notice.

NOTICE

1. This notice may be cited as the Traffic (Rodney County)

Notice No. 1, 1975. 2. The roads specified in the First Schedule hereto are hereby declared to be closely populated localities for the purposes of Section 52 of the Transport Act 1962. 3. The roads specified in the Second Schedule hereto are hereby declared to be 40-miles-an-hour speed limit areas for the purposes of regulation 27A of the Traffic Regulations 1956*.

4. The road specified in the Third Schedule hereto is hereby declared to be a closely populated locality for the purposes of section 52 of the Transport Act 1962, to the intent that a person driving any motor vehicle thereon at any time during the period commencing with the 1st day of December in each year and ending with the Tuesday following Easter in each following year shall be subject to the maximum speed limit of 30-miles-an-hour fixed by the said section. 5. The road specified in the Third Schedule hereto is hereby

5. The road specified in the Third Schedule hereto is hereby declared to be a 40-miles-an hour speed limit area for the purposes of regulation 27A of the Traffic Regulations 1956*, except during that period when clause 4 of this notice applies. 6. The road specified in the Fourth Schedule hereto is hereby declared to be a limited speed zone for the purposes of regulation 27 of the Traffic Regulations 1956*. 7. The roads specified in the Fifth Schedule hereto are hereby declared to be closely populated localities for the purposes of section 52 of the Transport Act 1962, to the intent that a person driving any motor vehicle thereon at any time during the period commencing with the 1st day of December in each year and ending with the Subject to the maximum speed limit of 30-miles-an-hour fixed by the said section. said section.

8. The Traffic (Rodney County) Notice No. 1, 1974, dated 1 August 1974* under section 52 of the Transport Act 1962 and regulations 27 and 27A of the Traffic Regulations 1956*, which relates to roads situated within Rodney County is hereby revoked.

FIRST SCHEDULE
