### DENIS BLUNDELL, Governor-General A PROCLAMATION

PURSUANT to section 63A (1) (a) of the Forests Act 1949, I, Sir Edward Denis Blundell, the Governor-General of New Zealand, hereby set apart the State forest land described in the Schedule hereto as a State Forest Park, to be known as Whakarewarewa State Forest Park.

PART Sections 4, 6, and 8, Block I, Tarawera Survey District; Section I, Block X, Tarawera Survey District; and Rotomahana-Parekarangi parts 4A, parts 6A2 No. 6A and B, 6L1, 6L2A, 6L2B2, 6L2B4, 6L2B5, part 6S1, part 6S2A, parts 6S2B, and part Te Kotuku-o-te-tama-whakara Block; situated in Blocks I, II, V, VI, IX, and X, Tarawera Survey District: area, 3830 hectares, more or less.
