*Notifying Issue of Writs, Date of Polling, etc.*

PURSUANT to a Warrant under the hand of His Excellency the Governor-General, dated the 30th day of October 1975 directed to the Clerk of Writs, I have this day issued writs to all Returning Officers authorising them to proceed to the election of members of Parliament for all electoral districts, and have fixed Thursday, the 6th day of November 1975, as the last day for the nomination of candidates, Saturday the 29th day of November 1975, as the day upon which the poll for such elections shall (if necessary) be taken, and Friday the 19th day of December 1975 as the day on or before which the said writs shall be returnable to me.
