

2. The area described in the Schedule hereto is hereby declared to be a marine reserve subject to the Marine Reserves Act 1971.

3. The costs of providing necessary navigational marks as required by the Ministry of Transport, but not the costs of their maintenance or renewal, shall be borne by the Ministry of Agriculture and Fisheries.
