Industries Development Commission Notice No. 1976/6—Inquiry Concerning Protection for New Zealand Industry Producing Certain Woven Polyester and Warp Knitted Curtain and Dress Net Fabrics Ex Tariff Headings 51.04, 56.07 and 60.01—Industries Development Commission Report No. 1976/3

At the request of the Minister of Trade and Industry, the Commission held a public hearing on 29 June-1 July 1976 concerning protection for New Zealand industry producing certain woven polyester and warp knitted curtain and dress net fabrics ex Tariff headings 51.04, 56.07 and 60.01.

The Commission has now completed its report which was forwarded to the Minister on 15 October 1976. A decision concerning the release of the report will be made by the Minister in due course.
