Provided that only one vessel is using the area at any one time motor launches and water skiers may travel at speeds greater than 8 km per hour between this notice and a marker post 850 metres distant upstream.

BATHERS KEEP OUT

2. There shall be erected at normal water levels on both banks of the Mokau River, at the upstream limits of the area described in the First Schedule, a conspicuous marker-post painted with 300mm bright orange and black bands.
