3. The roads specified in the Second Schedule hereto are hereby declared to be 70-kilometres-an-hour speed limit areas for the purposes of regulation 27A of the Traffic Regulations

4. The Traffic (Porirua City) Notice No. 2, 1973, dated the 31st day of October 1973†, under section 52 of the Transport Act 1962, and regulation 27A of the Traffic Regulations 1956*, which relates to roads situated within Porirua City is hereby revoked.
