A short review has been made of the Maori literature dealt with and an endeavour has been made to trace the history of the various mission and other private presses concerned. Any work, however small, printed wholly in Maori, or in Maori with a translation has been included; so also has any work dealing wholly with the Maori language—such as a dictionary.

CONFERENCE ON STATE AID TO PRIVATE SCHOOLS

This is the report of a steering committee set up by the Conference on State Aid to Private Schools called by the Government in May 1973. The steering committee reported in November 1974 and the conference resumed on 4 December 1974. The report covers a wide range of issues on State aid but in particular it sets out detailed proposals for the integration of private schools into the State system. These proposals were put together by a working party representative of private and State school interests and are under consideration by Government.
