NOTICE

1. (1) This notice may be cited as the Dunstan High School Board of Governors Notice 1976.

(2) This notice shall come into force on the 1st day of June 1976.

2. The Board of Governors of Dunstan High School shall be constituted as follows:

- (a) One member appointed by the Otago Education Board;
- (b) Seven members elected by the parents of pupils attending the school;
- (c) One member elected by the members of the school committees of the Alexandra School, the Blacks School, the Clyde School, the Lauder Railways School, the Omakau School, and the Terrace School;
- (d) One member appointed by the Central Otago Executive of the Women's Division of the Federated Farmers and the Central Otago Federation of the Country Women's Institute; and
- (e) One member co-opted by the Board itself, if and when it thinks fit.
