

Licensing Westport Concrete Ltd. to Occupy a Site for an Aerial Ropeway over the Buller River at Westport

PURSUANT to sections 162 and 265A of the Harbours Act 1950, I Owen John Conway, of the Ministry of Transport, in exercise of powers delegated by the Minister of Transport, hereby license and permit Westport Concrete Ltd. (hereinafter called the licensee, which term shall include its successors or assigns unless the context requires a different construction) to use and occupy a part of the foreshore and bed of the Buller River as shown on plan marked M.D. 15701 and deposited in the office of the Ministry of Transport at Wellington, for the purpose of maintaining thereon an aerial ropeway as shown on the said plan, such licence to be held and enjoyed by the licensee upon and subject to the terms and conditions set forth in the Schedule hereto.
