Grade Standards for the Export of Apples and Pears Notice 1976 (No. 1374 Ag. 12/2/14)

PURSUANT to regulation 13 of the New Zealand Grown Fruit and Vegetables Regulations 1975*, the Director-General of Agriculture and Fisheries hereby gives notice that the grade standards for the export of apples and pears shall be as set out in this notice.

NOTICE

1. **Title**—(1) This notice may be cited as the Grade Standards for the Export of Apples and Pears Notice 1976.

(2) This notice shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

2. **Application of Notice**—This notice determines the grade standards applicable for the export of apples and pears, and except with the prior written permission of the Director-General shall be the minimum grade standard for apples and pears exported from New Zealand.

3. **Title and grade**—The grade mark assigned to this standard grade shall be "Fancy Class I" (hereinafter referred to as "the grade").
